### **Transition Progress**

Leadership team continues to meet on Thursday morning to discuss current issues and plans for the upcoming week. This month's meeting have focused on commencement ceremonies, status of Summer/Fall registration, and review of pending action items from past Cabinet Meeting.

The Cabinet is set to begin review of the first drafts of the SACS internal audit process next week.

### **Legislative**

As of Wednesday morning, there was talk of a budget deal being close. Also the Campus Carry Bill, allowing handguns on campus is still alive. The current version of the bill has a provision that each institution would have the ability to decide if its campus would allow guns or not.

The current legislative session closes on May 27.

### **Construction**

The Del Rio site is progressing nicely. Foundations continue to be worked on, and should see an increase in the construction as all foundations are finalized.

### **Budgets**

Budgets have been submitted, been reviewed by the appropriate vice president, and are being compiled for review by the Cabinet. Pending the receipt of State Appropriation budget numbers, we will be ready for budget workshop with the board and a draft-operating budget for the June Board meeting.
