Description of Job Duties: Primary duties include teaching freshmen and sophomore courses in teaching discipline, recruiting and advising students, serving on division and college committees. Responsible for developing and updating curriculum, textbook/equipment selection, and instructional materials. Experience in teaching/advising/mentoring low income, first generation, educationally disadvantaged and at-risk students preferred. Work rules, code of conduct and other policies are part of the essential functions of the job. Ability to communicate effectively with students and college personnel. Teaching assignment will include courses for Dual Credit students; classes may be located on the SWTJC Del Rio Campus and at one or more San Felipe Del Rio Consolidated ISD locations. Course delivery modes may include face to face, remote and online.

Salary: Commensurate with education and teaching experience based on SWTJC salary schedule. Nine-month, non-tenure track faculty position.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Education: Master's degree in the discipline required or master's with a minimum of eighteen (18) graduate hours in philosophy required.

Additional Qualification Requirements: Must possess the required knowledge, skills, abilities and experience and be able to explain and demonstrate, with or without reasonable accommodations, the essential functions of the job. Experience in working with diverse populations. Candidate must be authorized to work in the U.S. and must provide verifiable credentials. Successful completion of the reference and background check specified for the position. Travel may be required to other geographic locations served by the college. Must have a valid Texas driver's license and be insurable through SWTJC insurers.
