  - iv. Copy of email from FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) detailing application process is completed

2. To submit an electronic scholarship application:

Please save this blank scholarship application to your computer by clicking “file”, “save as”, with following naming procedure: ***Your Last Name, Your First Name, SWTJC FAN App ----- Example: Doe, John, FAN App***. Close the form. Open the saved scholarship application and complete the form.

Email the completed form as an attachment to [cwbuchanan@swtjc.edu](mailto:cwbuchanan@swtjc.edu) no later than April 30, 2019. A scanned copy of two letters of recommendation as well as your high school transcript must be included with the submission. Remember to keep a copy for your records.

3. To submit a paper scholarship application:

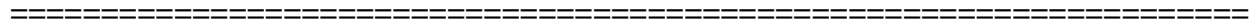
