Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN)

Position Summary:

Performs routine technical nursing duties and assists with other related duties involved in providing patient care. The LVN will work under the direction of the physician and supervision of the Director of Nursing.

Qualifications Required:

- Current Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN) in the State of Texas.
- Graduate from a State approved School of Vocational Nursing.
- Current CPR license through American Heart Association.
- All credentialed documents must be maintained current at all times and proof of such must be submitted to CHDI in a timely manner.
- Must be able to communicate effectively in English, both verbally and in writing.
- Computer literate.

Essential Functions:

- Engages in patient pre-visit and advanced care activities such as ordering lab tests, obtaining results, and patient reminders.
- Provides patient with evidence-based & self-care education for development of individual and disease specific care plans, visit summaries, medication management, educational resources, tools, etc.
- Track all lab and imaging orders and follow-up on missing or late results.
- Prepares patient for examination including identification of chief complaint, the taking of vital signs, height, weight, documents health histories, (i.e. data base updated annually) records medications being taken and observed symptoms, etc.
- Assesses immunization records and administers immunizations in accordance with Texas Department of State Health Services.

CHDI provides medical, dental, vision, and life insurance. As well as, paid time off and a retirement plan and is an Equal Employment Opportunity/Affirmative Action employer.
