The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2023 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for the Southwest Texas Junior College District from the same properties in both the 2022 tax year and the 2023 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that the Southwest Texas Junior College District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. That means that Southwest Texas Junior College District is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2023 tax year.

A public meeting to vote on the proposed tax rate will be held on September 21, 2023, at 6:00 pm in the Bluebonnet Room of the Matthews Student Center on the Uvalde Campus of Southwest Texas Junior College.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Southwest Texas Junior College District is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the Board of Trustees Administrator, Nita Reed, of the Southwest Texas Junior College District at her office or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
