Garner Science Building

You will see an action item on this month's Board Agenda to authorize us to request competitive sealed proposal for the modifications needed at the Garner Science Building. The Mechanical Engineers have developed plans to bring a ventilation system into the chemistry lab and storage rooms in order to make the building compliant. In a very broad sense, this will involve the addition of two large air conditioning units to increase the amount of fresh air coming into the facility. We will also be replacing fume exhaust fans and vents. These additions will require an expansion of our electrical systems and some structure reinforcements. Our goal is to receive bids back and bring to the March Board meeting for consideration.
