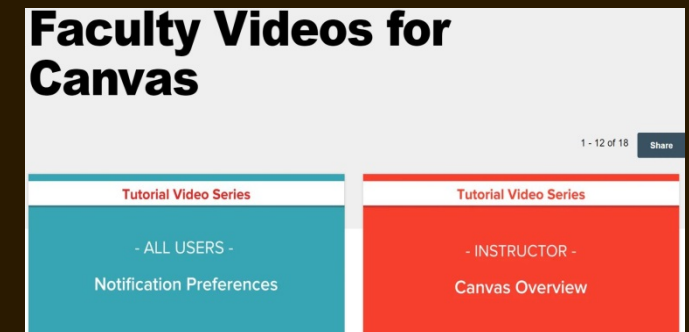
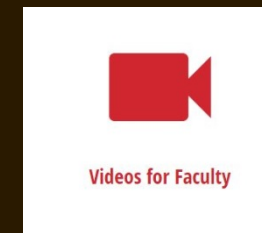
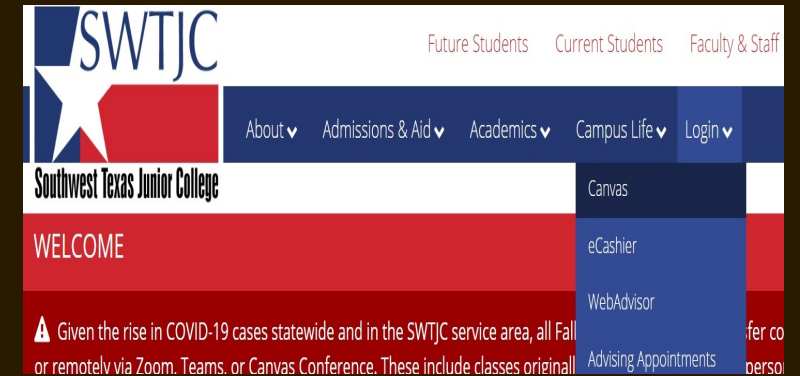

4. Videos will appear for you



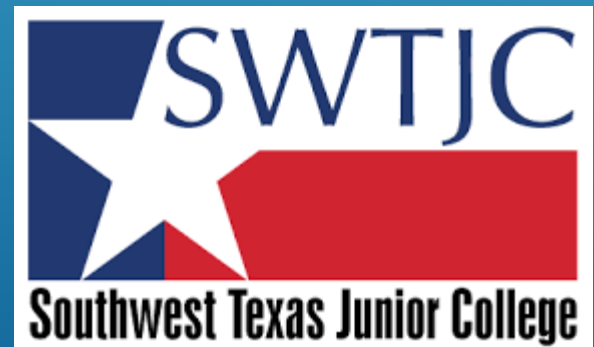

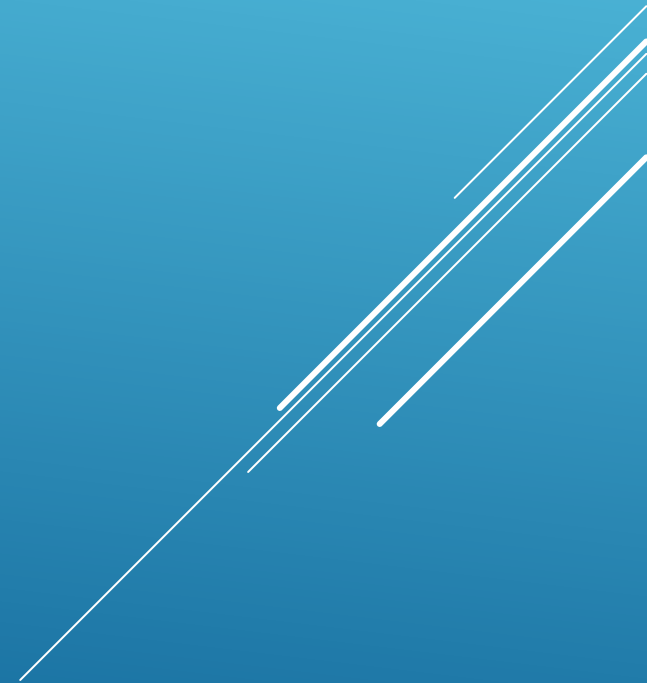
